

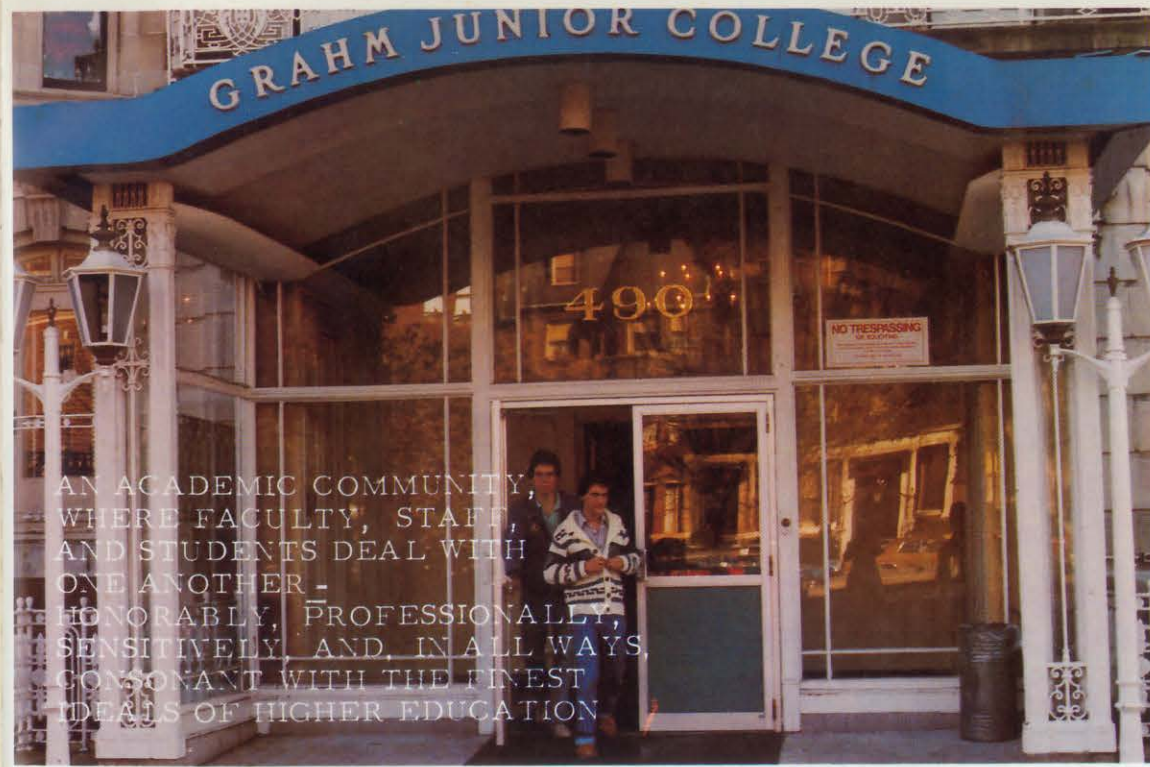

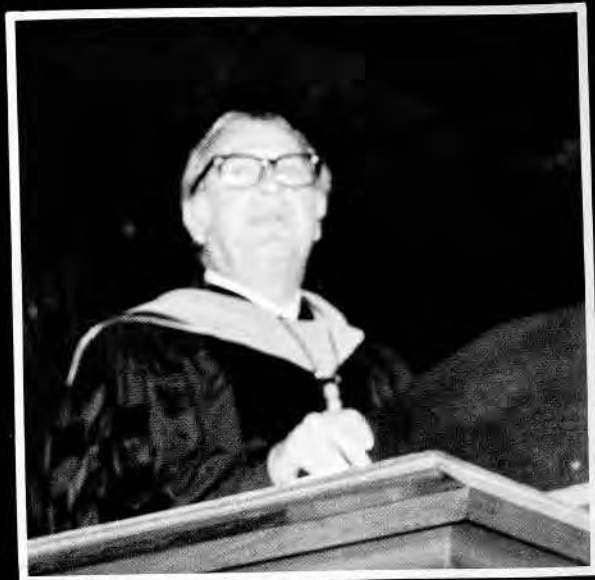


Some fifty students at Graham Junior College in Boston began a hunger strike last Tuesday in an attempt to stop the college's closure.

Hall, along with many supporters, as the college's administration

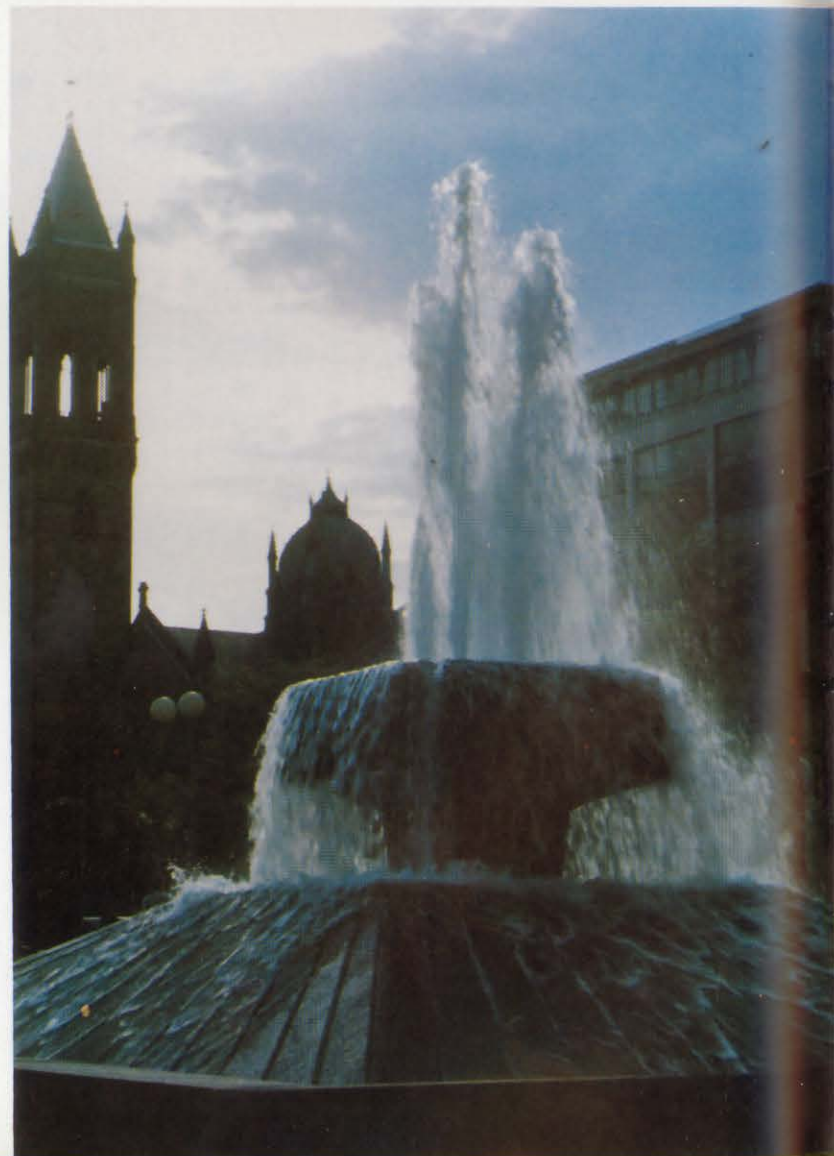
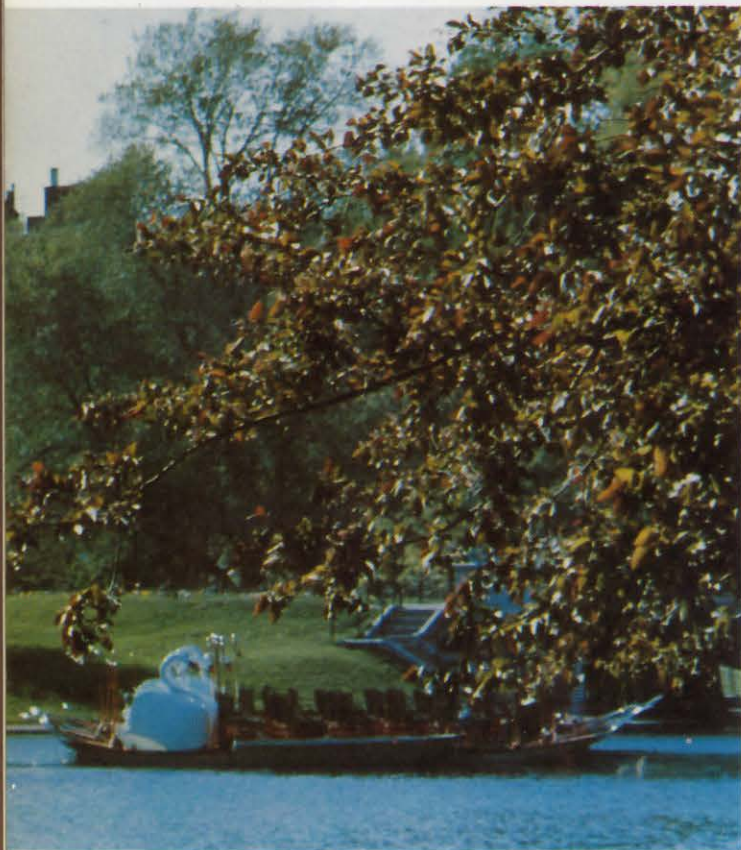
